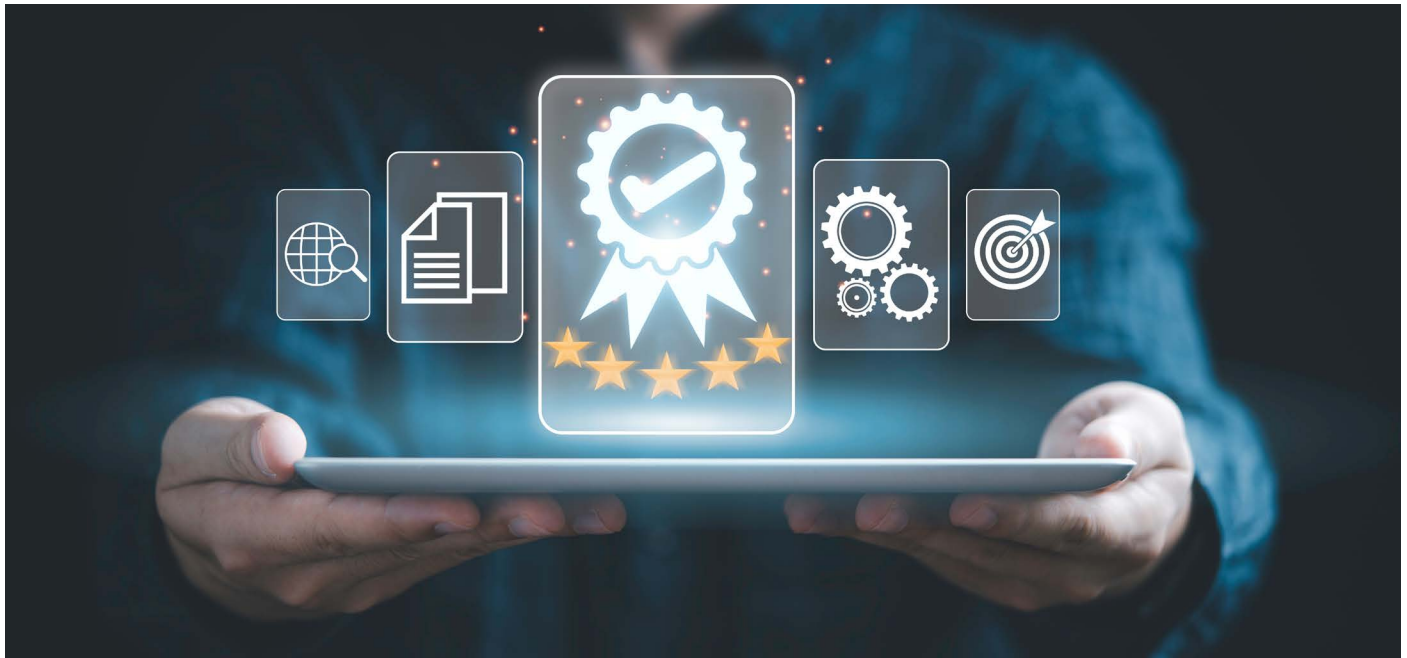

Certification program details

- OpenText certifications are valid for a three-year period. Renewal of an expired certification requires completion of the current exam.
- Renewal of a certification is available at a 50-percent discount off list price until the certification expires.
- OpenText strongly recommends completion of pre-requisite courses before attempting a certification exam.
- Certification exams can have other certification pre-requisites. Pre-requisite certifications are mandatory.
- The candidate must achieve a passing grade to obtain a certification. (Grade depends on the specific exam).
- Participants who pass an exam cannot take the exam again to improve their results.
- If a candidate fails their first attempt to pass any certification exam, OpenText does not require any waiting period between the first and second attempts.
- A candidate shall be required to wait a period of at least 14 days before a third or any subsequent attempt(s). One attempt is included with each certification exam purchase. Second and subsequent attempt(s) need to be purchased separately.
- Disclosure of exam content and other acts of misconduct during or after the certification are strictly prohibited. If such an act occurs, the certification will not be awarded or may be revoked.
