Screen reader announces only 'yes' when the focus is on Inherit RM Classification radio button, its associated correctly on the Functions Menu dropdown icon. Screen reader announces, "Function Menu Graphic" instead of "Function Menu Dropdown Button". Label is not correctly associated with the Current Search Form field on the Advanced Search page.

		 Label is not associated correctly on the Birthday Date selection box. Screen reader announces, "combo box" instead of "Birthday selection box". Label is not associated correctly on the Edit button. Screen reader announces, "that starts with" instead of "Edit Button". When pressing the table short cut key 'T', the screen reader announces as table with three columns and fifteen rows where there is no Data Table available. This issue occurs with all the screen flows on the Add Item page. Label is not associated correctly for the Notification Message list box and Schedule Days or Time selection check boxes. Screen reader announces only the value and not the associated label to the user. The caption is not provided for table elements in multiple pages. Screen reader announces, "Table with seven columns and ten rows" and not the correct caption for the form table fields. On all the web pages the Content Server and Browse Window title text is defined as Heading H1. Labels are not associated correctly for the Date only field. Screen reader announces, "Date Read only Edit" when the focus is on the Date field.

Using Internet Explorer 11, the Select Node dialog does not respond to TAB and ENTER for selections. It responds to space bar. The Add Item menu cannot be closed using the ESC key. User must tab to the end of the list. Improve the Search Result page to better support keyboard navigation. Result Display Style field on the Advanced Search page is not accessible with keyboard navigation. With the screen reader ON, user is not able to perform keyboard-based access on any of the pages opened from links under the Add Item menu option. The Calendar Menu icon is not accessible with keyboard navigation. The Filter by Search icon is not accessible with keyboard navigation. Manage Shares widget is not usable for keyboard users.

Exceptions will be tracked as defects. These defects will be fixed in a service pack or future release. Bug reference LPAD-72133. When adding an additional value during Category creation for a Multiline Field Attribute, focus is not placed in the newly added field. Instead, it is placed outside the area and user must use the TAB key to get back to the field. When a user opens the Add Document page the keyboard selection control focus goes to the non-interactive element. When a user opens any Add Item page the selection focus goes to the top address bar and not the next interactive element.

State information (expanded/collapsed) is not defined for the Open Search button on the Search Bar. The role and state are not defined correctly for the Navigate to link. The screen reader announces the link as "Navigate to dot dot dot link". The role and state are not defined correctly for the All Items Types clickable element. The screen reader announces the link as "Left parent All item types right parent link" instead of "All item types". The role and state are not defined correctly for the Enterprise menu/sub-menu items. The screen reader announces the Enterprise menu as "Slices sub-menu Enterprise" and when the sub-menus are selected announces "Slices Workspace".
