Only simple text can be edited on a Wiki page when using only a keyboard. Initial focus position is not uniform when opening various instances of tables. In Business Workspaces, keyboard navigation is cumbersome, differing between forward and backward directions.

		 Unable to navigate to the Comments, Favorites, and More Actions icon using the keyboard when working with Business Workspaces. Improve the Search Result page to better support keyboard navigation. In the Create dialog of Business Workspaces, keyboard focus order does not follow standards. In the Metadata view and Document Overview page, keyboard focus reaches non-active elements. The keyboard navigation in the pagination control of the Search views does not follow standards. Long descriptions of Business Workspaces cannot be scrolled into view using the keyboard. When editing a URL field in the Metadata view, the focus moves unexpectedly after saving. In My Assignments view, the button to search in the Location column cannot be reached using only the keyboard. In Search views some buttons cannot be reached using only the keyboard once the filter facets control is activated. In Browse View, it is not possible to create shortcuts to other documents using only the keyboard. In Grid View, some state icons of the elements cannot be reached using only the keyboard.

Incorrect focus order when removing workspace relationships. Keyboard navigation across the Browse View is cumbersome with Internet Explorer browser. In View Record Details functionality, keyboard navigation is very cumbersome. Keyboard navigation arrow keys do not adopt to right-toleft views. For example, in tables or toolbars. When using item selection check boxes in the Standard Search view, the keyboard focus changes unexpectedly.

A document'sPermissions page is hard to use with some screen readers. The input field of the general user picker control presents conflicting role information to screen reader users. Status cells in the Browse View table cannot be accessed with a screen reader when more than one status item is present inside the cell. In the Browse View, the headline above the table is not recognized as headline by screen readers. The Document Overview page is difficult to comprehend for screen reader users. Item names as header of the Browse View pages often can be directly edited but this is not made clear enough for screen reader users. Some column headers of the Holds table lack an audible text for screen reader users. When using the node picker control, the selected/cleared state is not audible for users of the JAWS screen reader. The type ahead search control does not support screen reader users properly. The general show/hide breadcrumbs toggle presents no role to a screen reader making it hard to use. The Browse View tables have column headers with two functionalities: sorting and filtering. This causes complex output in some screen readers.
