In 2019, the FCC issued a Memorandum of Opinion and Order 19-72 allowing companies to decommission copper wire phone services as early as August 2022. During its inquiry, the FCC determined that the public interest is no longer served by maintaining legacy regulatory obligations and the associated costs of copper wire phone lines.

Copper wire telephone systems are old and expensive, and new technologies are taking over the market. This phase out will impact anyone using copper wire POTS (Plain Old Telephone System) lines. Anyone faxing with these lines should consider switching before they are caught by surprise with the cancellation or unregulated price increase of maintaining analog lines.

With a digital fax solution, an organization can create a path to modernization explicitly designed for its specific needs. Moving to a cloud or hybrid solution eliminates reliance on copper and analog lines and provides other tremendous benefits. 
