

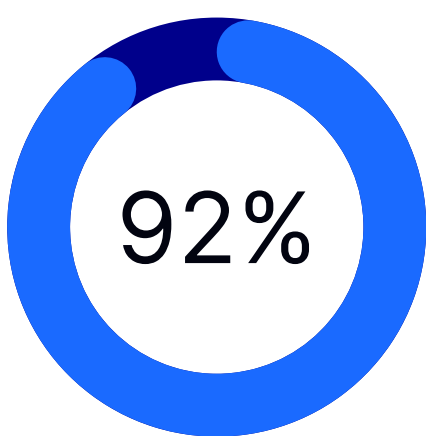

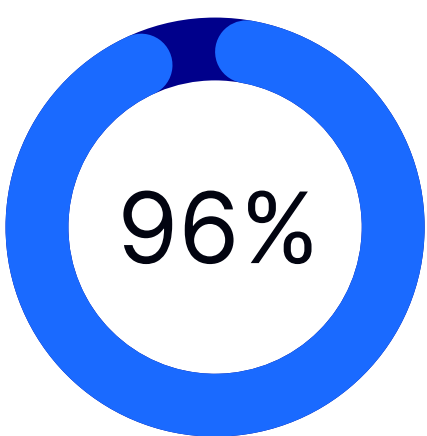

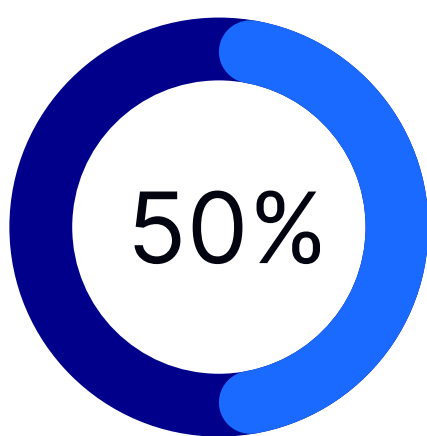
RISING AI EXPECTATIONS HIGHLIGHT THE GAP BETWEEN DEMAND AND

... and the majority of MSPs believe that AI interest will drive business growth this year

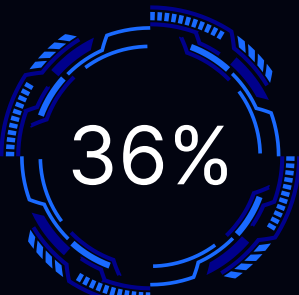


Despite these findings, only about half feel fully ready to guide SMBs in deploying AI tools

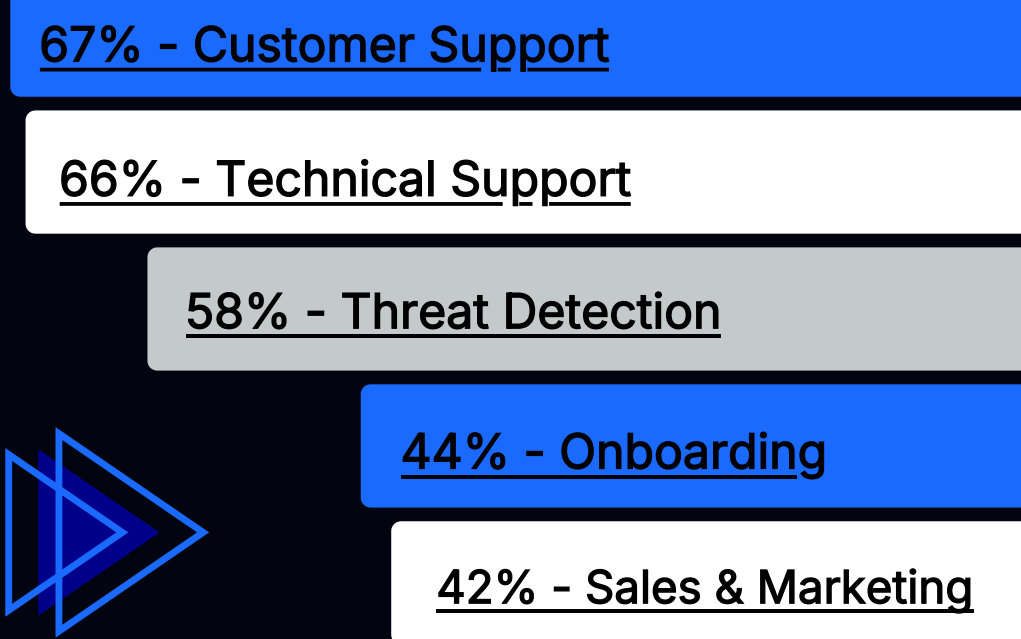


About half of MSPs have developed and deployed AI Cybersecurity agents for SMB Customers

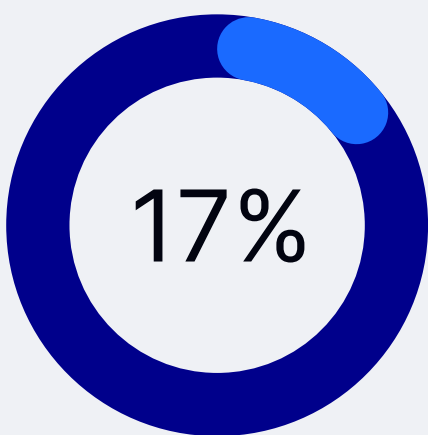


While less than half are experimenting internally but have not rolled them out quite yet.

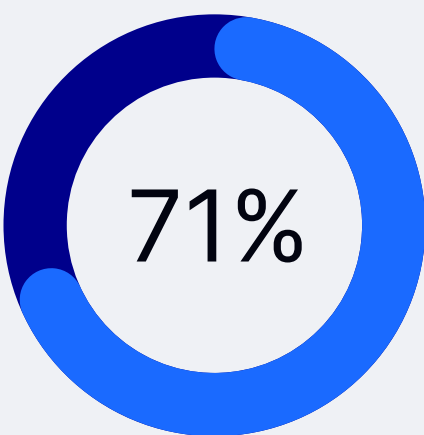
While customer-facing AI services are still limited, MSPs are rapidly adopting generative AI internally, with adoption expanding across core functions and security offerings such as



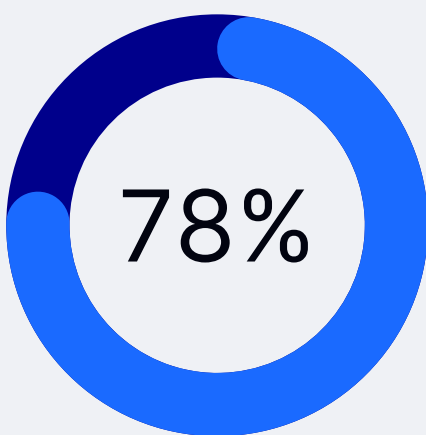
SHIFTING PRIORITIES: SMBs VALUE SIMPLICITY AND SECURITY ABOVE COST



Customers citing cost savings as a primary challenge has decreased steadily, falling from 28% in 2023 to 17% in 2025



SMBs are driving demand for bundled offerings, with MSPs citing comprehensive prevention, detection, and response packages as the top choice



More than three-quarters of MSPs rate ease of integration as an “extremely important” decision factor, outranking vendor count

MANAGING TOOL FATIGUE WHILE ENSURING FLEXIBILITY EMERGES
 AS A LEADING CHALLENGE FOR SMB CUSTOMERS

- Most Common Complaints:
- Expensive licensing (51%)
 - Complexity and Steep Learning Curves (48%)
 - Too many tools to manage (42%)
- Other Significant Frustrations:
- Poor interoperability (31%)
 - Insufficient visibility (39%)
 - Lack of automation (40%)

- Desired Improvements:
- Pre-integrated vendor ecosystems (24%)
 - Single-pane-of-glass management platforms (24%)
 - AI-based orchestration and automation (23%)

MSPs are feeling the effects of tool fatigue, most reporting that this is a leading challenge for their clients, and they are eager to assist in overcoming this obstacle.

In response, a growing number of providers are developing or evaluating new managed service offerings, with ease of integration seen as the most critical value driver, followed by solutions that can be widely adopted across SMB verticals.

Survey methodology

In September 2025, OpenText Cybersecurity surveyed 1,019 managers, c-level executives, security professionals, and customer relationship managers at MSPs in the United States, the United Kingdom and Canada. Respondents represented MSPs ranging in size from 1 to 500 employees.
