		 In Business Workspaces, keyboard navigation is cumbersome, differing between forward and backward directions. Unable to navigate to the Comments, Favorites, and More Actions icon using the keyboard when working with Business Workspaces. Improve the Search Result page to better support keyboard navigation. When editing a URL field in the Metadata view, the focus moves unexpectedly after saving. In Grid View, some state icons of the elements cannot be reached using only the keyboard. Inside a create document dialog, Shift-Tab does not work in a Records Management Classification. The Workflow Tracking widget cannot be used by keyboard alone. The edit mode of a workspace picker field is closed and shows an error when using F2 without having selected a valid value. Documents cannot be created with keyboard only if they have mandatory category values which are implemented by a NodePicker. In the Notification Center dialog the details of an insight cannot be reached using the keyboard only. The Workflow Monitoring widget cannot be used by keyboard alone. Table navigation and column headers are not working via arrow keys.

The general show/hide breadcrumbs toggle presents no role to a screen reader making it hard to use. The Browse View tables have column headers with two functionalities: sorting and filtering. This causes complex output in some screen readers. Reserve / Unreserve button in the Properties page is not read by screen reader software. The Notification Center functionality cannot be used by users of screen reader software.

		 TKL attributes cannot be read by screen reader software in the metadata pages. The User Picker control label cannot be read by screen reader while in edit mode.
