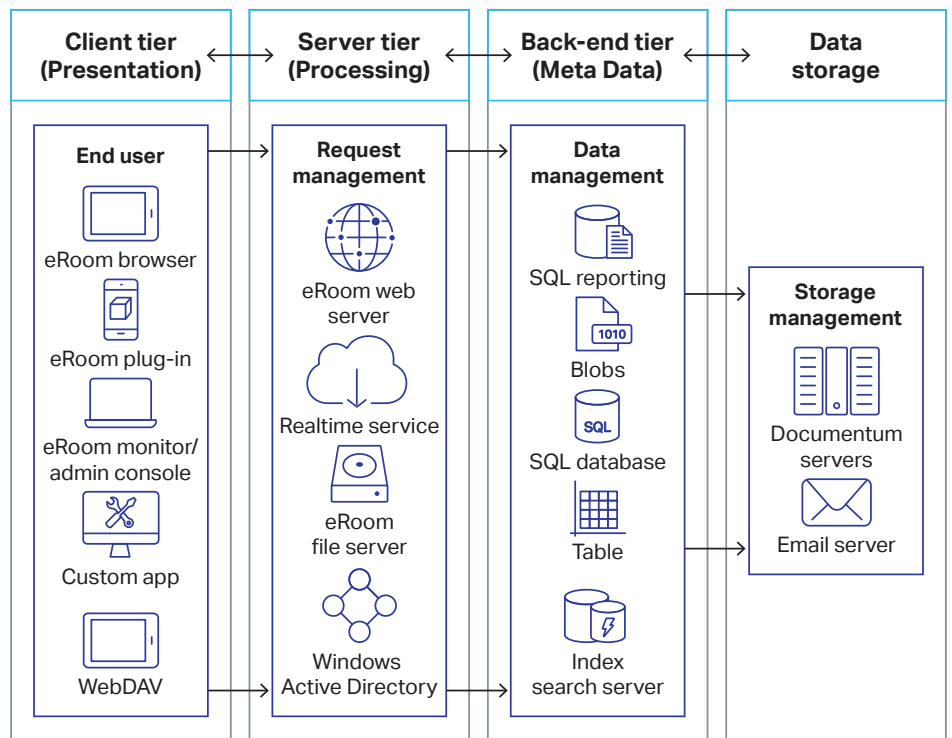
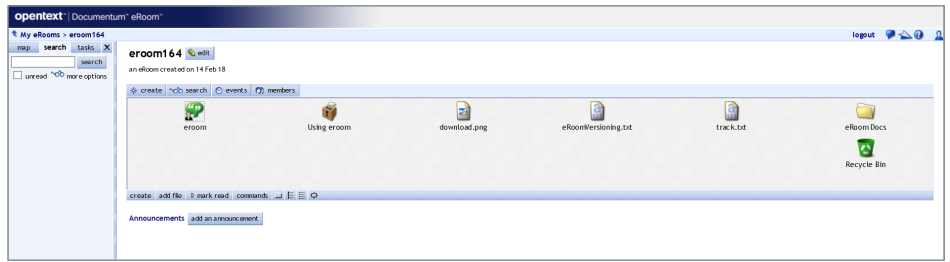


Figure 1: Architecture diagram

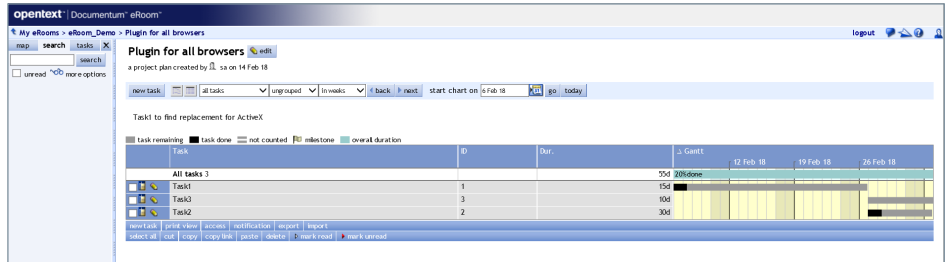

Completely web-based	Requires only an internet connection and web browser, which is especially useful for geographically dispersed workers

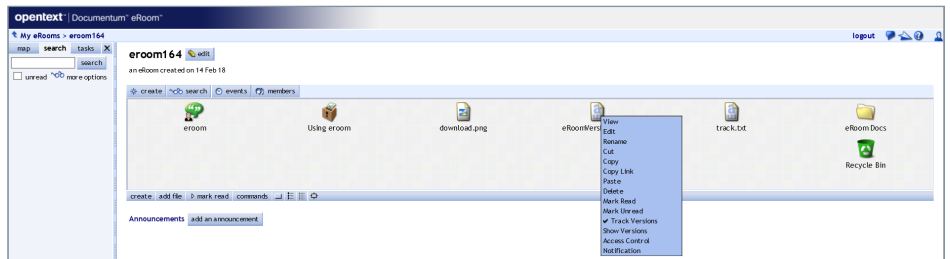
